Please make sure to choose the right format for your paper and closely follow the guidelines for your chosen manuscript format.

Time line

Submissions via PLAT website are welcome as of September 20th 2017 until January 12th 2018. Authors will receive feedback from two peer-reviewers and the editor before April 2018. A second round of reviews, if necessary, will be finalized and the final decisions made until October 2018. The special issue is planned to be the March issue of PLAT 2019.
